Our personalised care leads to successful and healthy ageing.


This is our person-centred approach where we focus on you as an individual; your stories, your abilities and your physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs.

Your Care Plan is fundamental to how we respond to you. When you join Catholic Homes an individual Care Plan is developed with you by our experienced team.

We talk to you about your life and what is important to you. We focus on your health care needs and what you want to achieve.

We support people to achieve their potential, centred on the knowledge of their past, their current abilities and physical, social and emotional needs.

A Care Plan is forever changing, so that the healthcare and support you receive will best meet your needs, preferences and goals.

Our aim is to ensure you have greater understanding, control, independence and management of the care and services you have at Catholic Homes.

Enabling environments in residences

At Catholic Homes we strive to create places to encourage and enable independence.

Our 'enabling environments' make it easier for people, particularly those living with dementia or other cognitive impairments, to better understand and participate in the world around them.

At all our residences you will see name badges, labels and clear information, inviting people to participate, to do new things and develop new friendships.

Lounges and dining areas invite you to join in, take on a role if you desire, so that you feel engaged, while you make a valued contribution.



Clear signage makes it easier to get around and find things to do, that enhance your independence and give more meaning to your day, whether it's making a cuppa, enjoying a hobby or helping around your home.

Your role

We promote independence by encouraging and supporting people to do as much as they can for themselves; to be engaged in activities and hobbies that add value to their lives.

You can choose a role or a task, big or small, which helps you feel engaged, productive and valued. As well as restoring function, helping around the home can improve your confidence and self-esteem.
